WALLWORKS NEW YORK TO OPEN NEW SPACE AT BRONX KREATE HUB THIS SATURDAY WITH GROUP EXHIBITION!

After five successful years on Bruckner Blvd., WALLWORKS NEW YORK is ready to open its doors at their new space at Bronx Kreate Hub this Saturday. On January 11, the new gallery space will hold a reception for their first show of the new year—a group exhibition celebrating the talent and creativity of The Bronx.

The Bronx Does It Better will feature works from Bronx-born artists, Bronx-based artists and artists whose work celebrates and elevates The Bronx.
